#### CONGRESSMAN MURPHY VISITS ADELPHOI VILLAGE

LATROBE, PA--Congressman Tim Murphy will meet with Adelphoi Management on July 8, 2010 at 2 p.m. at Adelphoi's main campus in Latrobe. Congressman Murphy will discuss the Employee Free Choice Act (EFCA), funds cut from the 2011 budget for the Federal Medical Assistance Percentages (FMAP), and Title IV-E of the Social Security Act.

After the meeting, Congressman Murphy, will take a tour of Adelphoi's main campus in Latrobe, PA. The visit is part of Adelphoi's effort to engage in discussion with legislators in order to promote critical services for children, youth, and families.

Congressman Tim Murphy is serving his fourth term in Congress representing the 18th District of Pennsylvania. He relies on his three decades as a child psychologist to advocate for meaningful reforms in the U.S. healthcare system and is one of only a handful of members of Congress with a background in healthcare. He is Co-chair of the 21st Century Healthcare Caucus, Mental Health Caucus, GOP Doctor's Caucus, and Men's Health Caucus, giving him a platform to educate other members of Congress and the public on ways to make healthcare more affordable and accessible for all families.

Adelphoi Village is a not-for-profit agency dedicated to providing a continuum of quality services to children, youth and families. Headquartered in Latrobe, the organization has programs in 30 counties, serving over 800 youth and families on a daily basis and over 2,500 children annually. Among the scope of services offered by Adelphoi are 20 group homes, a charter school, secure treatment centers, alternative education and day treatment programs, foster care, shelter programs, mental health services, in-home services and multistystemic therapy.
